MID-DAY PROGRAMME

Available for kids everyday from 11h00 to 14h00. Meet at Children's Centre at 11h00, where they will be looked after by a dedicated 'kiddies coordinator', and receive their Kids on Safari goodie bag.

EDU-TRAIL

- On the trail, kids will learn more about our beautiful surroundings and the miracles of nature, including seeing animal skulls, plants, insects, tracks & dung middens, etc.
- The kids may learn how to create moulds of animal tracks using Plaster of Paris – the moulds can serve as a souvenir and a nice reminder of their time at Kariega.
- Kids target practise, where they can practise their skills at shooting a traditional "Kettie" (which is a safe Y shaped slingshot).
- Kids will have the opportunity to be creative and attempt to make their very own "Bushman paintings". Other bushcraft and wildlife survival skills may be illustrated by the guide (depending on the age of the group).
- Environmental education using natural items from the bush eg. Ostrich eggs, porcupine quills, skulls etc.



GYM POLICY

No children 10 years and under can utilize the gym. Children between the ages of 11 and 14 must have parental supervision.



PLAYROOM

Situated at the restaurant complex and available all day. Ideal when the weather is bad or during evening meal time – when Mom and Dad have to deal with restless kids! The playroom is well equipped with:

- Books, toys, black-board, puzzles, games, building blocks, colouring-in, play-dough, etc.
- Table tennis (in conference room)
- Fun and wildlife DVDs



CHILDREN ON GAME DRIVES

We encourage all children to enjoy morning and afternoon game drives with their parents (as well as the river cruise). This includes all ages but for children 5 years and under, it is in the Guide's and ultimately the General Manager's discretion as to whether they can be taken into sightings of the more dangerous "Big-5" animals, for safety reasons.
